The undersigned assumes full responsibility for all items borrowed and absolves the 1st Merrickville Scout group and it's leaders of all responsibility. It is the responsibility of the undersigned to ensure the equipment is used in a safe manner and all adults and youth utilising the equipment have the appropriate training for the conditions under which the equipment will be used. Canoeing in moving water requires specialised skills for both the adults and youth. The trailer and equipment are not covered by any insurance.

Activities specifically prohibited:

- Use of canoes in any organised, professional, charitable, or other type of race.
- Use of Cottager canoes in any type of running/white water, or where the canoes are exposed to rocks.
- Dropping the canoes or dragging the canoes over rocks.
