## Forms

- Please list an email address if possible. We use this for communicating activity information.
- Ensure that both a full street address and PO Box/Rural Route number are given.

## Be a leader!

- Adults who enjoy camping and playing with kids, and who are looking for an excuse to get out more, should contact us for available leadership roles.

## Uniform

- Full uniform is mandatory for all youth.
  - Beavers: Vest and hat.
  - Cubs: Tan shirt, Cub sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Cub handbook.
  - Scouts: Tan shirt, Scout sash, navy blue trousers/shorts, Scout handbook.
- The trousers/shorts must be a solid colour: no stripes, flowers, embroidery, etc.
- The Scout field book is highly recommended for Scouts.

## Village of Merrickville Child Surtax

- The Village of Merrickville has implemented a child tax of \$1/child/night for the use of the "Community" Centre.
- We are required to collect and submit this tax. Notification will be given at the first meeting on how this tax is to be paid.

## Cost

- Scouts Canada registration fee is \$135 for the first child, and \$110 for each subsequent child in the same family.
- This entire fee goes to Scouts Canada for their administrative expenses, none remains with the group.
- Cheques may be postdated no later than September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Cheques should be made payable to "Scouts Canada".
- No refunds after September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Financial assistance is available.
