## Instructions

The objective is for each lodge to make the most money possible.

Divide the Beavers into lodges of about six Beavers each.

Each lodge is given \$100 in Monopoly money.

The Beavers have to purchase the material needed to make things from the Trading Post stall. They then have to make the items that the Trading Post wants to buy. They can use the profits from selling items to purchase more material to make other things.

The winning lodge is the one that has the most money at the end of the game.

Scissors (to cut string)  
Paper, 8 1/2" x 11", white, 500 sheets  
Pencil crayons, lots, must include red  
Bread, white, 3 loaves (slices cut in half to go further)  
Jam, 2 jars  
Knife, 10  
Pencil, 20  
Styrofoam cups for jam

### Game Instructions for Beavers
