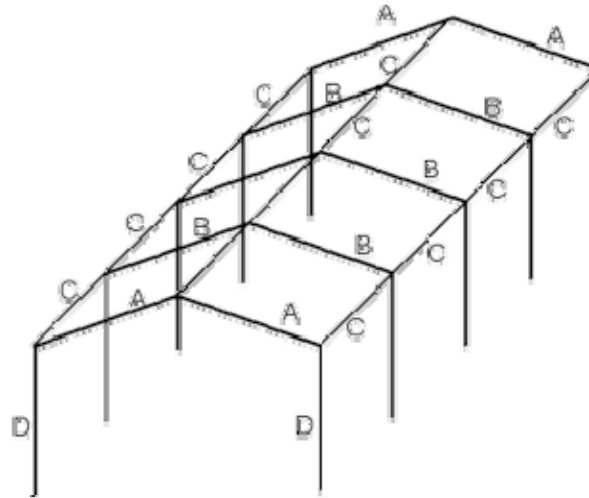


1 3/8 Inch Tubing Cut List for 18 ft. 9 3/4 in. X 40 Foot Canopy using a 20X40 Foot Tarp

Medium Gable Peak Canopy with valance (110 Degree slope, 4 inch rise/foot)



Tubing requirements:

Cut into the follow pieces:

Purchase 1 3/8 inch Chain link fence tubing

Chain link fence tubing can be purchased in lengths up to 20 feet or can be purchased precut into the following sizes:

Label	Name	Number of pieces	Length of Pieces
A	End Roof Rafters	4	10 ft.
B	Middle Roof Rafters	6	9 ft. 10 in.
C	Roof Ridge and Sides	12	10 ft.
D	Legs (Note 1)	10	7 ft.

Note 1: Legs can be cut to any desired length. Structures with side height greater than 8 feet should only be constructed with 1 3/8, 1 5/8 or 1 7/8 inch tubing materials.

Approximate final dimensions:

These are approximate final dimensions. They may vary slightly with variations in cut lengths, tarp variations and assembly.

Tarp Size	20X40
Peak Height	10 ft. 5 3/4 in.
Side Height	7 ft.
Front Opening Width	18 ft. 9 3/4 in.
Length	40 ft.

⚠️ All canopy shelters should be considered temporary structures and are not designed to withstand acts of nature such as heavy wind and snow. Anchoring of canopies is strongly recommended.
