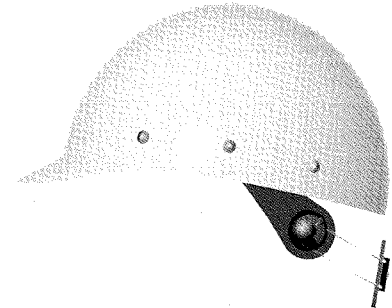
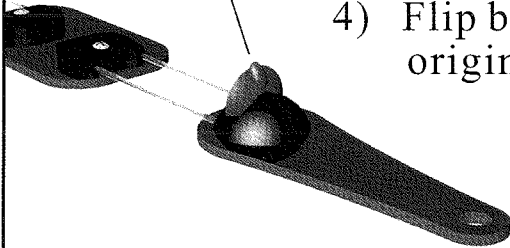


# HOG

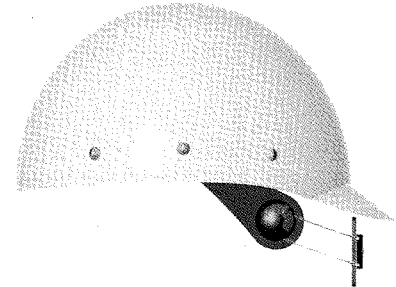
## Retention System

- 2) Flip up both blue tabs.
- 3) Turn tabs clockwise until HOG against head.
- 4) Flip blue tabs back to their original position.

## WARNING!

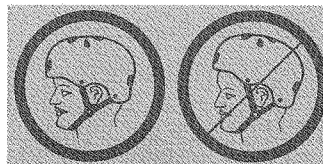
Some reasonable foreseeable impacts may exceed this or any helmet's capability to protect you against severe injury or death. Shred Ready helmets are designed for whitewater paddlesports and non-motorized watersports only and are not designed to protect the neck or face in the event of an accident. Make sure the helmet is properly fitted and fastened for maximum protection. Always paddle within your skill level.

## ADDITIONAL WARNING!

- 1) For adequate protection, this helmet has to fit or be adjusted to the size of the user's head
- 2) The helmet is designed to absorb shock and impact by partial destruction of the shell and liner / harness material, and even though such damage may not be readily apparent, any helmet subjected to a severe impact should be replaced.
- 3) No attachments or modifications should be made to the helmet except those recommended by the manufacturer.
- 4) Fitting pad should cover all snaps connections at all times on earflap compatible helmets while the earflaps are removed. Additionally, you should snap in the Snap Covers when the earflaps are not installed in your helmet.
- 5) The helmet may be damaged and rendered ineffective by petroleum and petroleum products, cleaning agents, paints, adhesives, etc without damage being visible to the user.
- 6) For cleaning, maintenance or disinfection, use only substances that have no adverse effect on the helmet and are not known to be likely to have any adverse effect upon the wearer, when applied in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and information.
- 7) Transport you helmet in a soft gear bag. Do not throw heavy objects on the helmet or transport under heavy objects which may cause damage to the helmet that is not visible.
- 8) Clean with warm water and mild soap.
- 9) You should replace your helmet every three years.

## FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Place helmet on head and buckle straps.
- 2) Adjust wedge adjusters just under the each ear.
- 3) Pull buckle tight, do not wear helmet with straps that are loose.
- 4) Test the helmet by rocking it forwards and back.
- 5) If helmet is lose or rocks forward or back use wedge adjusters to apply tension forwards or backwards on straps.
- 6) If the helmet is too loose you will need a smaller size.
- 7) If helmet is too tight you will need a larger sized helmet.



## WARRANTY

If there is a problem with your helmet, give us a call and explain your difficulties and we will either repair or replace your helmet at our discretion.
